Planning Application at former Wesleyan Methodist Chapel, Blackhorse Road, Kingswood (PK15/4995/F)

Further to our last letter, we are writing to let you know of the date when a decision will be made on the planning application to convert the former Wesleyan Methodist Chapel on Blackhorse Road, Kingswood into 15 flats and the creation of a car parking area over part of the burial ground.

This decision-making meeting will take place on Thursday 30th June at Kingswood Civic Centre. The meeting starts at 3pm. Anyone who has written to the Council about this application should also receive notification direct from the planning department. The application for the chapel is the first application on the agenda after minor administrative items.

There are opportunities at the meeting for residents to speak to the Committee and the order of items on the Agenda is sometimes altered depending upon whether members of the public wish to speak or not. Five minutes in total are allocated for objectors and five minutes are also allocated for those in favour. It is advisable to let the Committee clerk know in advance that you wish to speak - his name is Tim Milgate (01454 863013 / tim.milgate@southglos.gov.uk).

If you have access to the Internet, we have created shortcuts (case-sensitive) to the paperwork for the application (<http://tinyurl.com/ChapelApp>) and also the decision-making meeting on the 30th June (items numbered 12 and 13 at <http://tinyurl.com/ChapelAppDCEast>) - the link for the 30th June meeting features the planning officer's reports and recommendations - which is to approve the application.

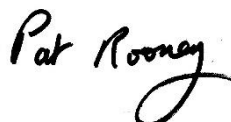
